The Emblem of Betar is the Menerah, the ancient Jewish Symbol, dating back to the period of the Maccahim. Betar is particularly proud of the fact that Israel has Official State Emblem and Seal.

Betar was the largest Jew-ish youth movement before World War II, numbering over 105,000 members, 60,000 in Poland alone.

Betar has established the first Marine School, dating back to 1934, and also the first "Air School," founded in 1939, preparing Jewish youth for their future tasks,

The World Headquarters of Betar are situated in Israel and are called "Shilton Betar."

Menachem Begin, one of the outstanding statesene in Esrael, is the Head of the World Betar Movement to-day.
